- Built an order management system with authentication, shipment tracking, and summary views to improve operational transparency (avg. ~10 orders/month).
- Owned production operations end-to-end (server maintenance, domain configuration, and ICP filing/compliance in China), and supported ongoing maintenance while studying full-time in the U.S.

### OptionLab — Options Mispricing Screener & Analytics Platform

- Built an options analytics platform that flags potentially mispriced contracts by comparing theoretical values vs market prices; uses volatility/price dislocations to infer market sentiment.
- Implemented hybrid pricing engine (Black-Scholes for European; CRR binomial tree for American) with full Greeks; delivered implied volatility analytics (IV, IV percentile) and an interactive 3D volatility surface; supports options-chain filtering (expiry/moneyness/volume/OI).
- Currently developing multi-leg strategy recognition (vertical spreads, straddles/strangles, iron condors, butterflies, calendar spreads) with combined Greeks, P&L and breakeven visualization, watchlists, CSV export, Docker deployment, and API documentation.

- Manage a self-directed portfolio across China mutual funds, U.S. equities, digital assets, and digital collectibles; growth-oriented, thesis-driven approach supported by investment memos and periodic reviews.
